4th eGOIA Plenary

The fourth plenary meeting of the eGOIA Project took place at the Centro de Pesquisas Renato Archer, in Campinas – SP, establishing the end of the first stage (phase) activities with the demonstration of the eGOIA prototype (model) operation in laboratory environment.

Partners from Germany (FOKUS, INI-Graphics), England (Helios), Portugal (Meticube) and Brazil (Sao Paulo State Government, ABEP) presented the fundamental aspects of the assessment and dissemination, of eGOIA while discussing the Project's sustainability. Accomplished and programmed dissemination activities were discussed the proposals for phase II.

At first it has been defined that, in August, the Poupatempo at the town of Guarulhos / São Paulo, will receive the eGOIA prototype for a real operating environment testing.

ABEP has presented the results of the Research on the Electronic Govern Services conducted in the Brazilian States.

Partners discussed the possible practices for the dissemination of information and achieved Project results.

On stage (phase) II eGOIA must take care of questions related to technical interoperability, selection and evaluation of the possible services to be rendered on eGOIA project, creation of the eGOV virtual center, among other.

A next eGOIA partners meeting has been scheduled for November 2005, in Sao Paulo.

Partners must go also to Peru in November (CONCYTEC) in order to follow the launching of the eGOIA demonstrator by town governments in that country.
